2015 PACIFIC GAMES VISITORS FIREARMS LICENSES AND AMMUNITION

Firearms and Ammunition

All athletes bringing firearms into Papua New Guinea for the 2015 Pacific Games will require a Visitor Firearm Permit before arrival into PNG. A Visitor's Firearm Licence will only be issued to a person competing in the shooting events.

An application for a Visitor's Firearm Licence is to be made at least 50 days prior to the date of the proposed visit. This time period is required to ensure that all enquiries and statutory checks are completed and that the licence is forwarded prior to the visit.

All athletes importing ammunition are required to list their ammunition on the Visitor Firearm Permit obtained for their weapon.

All overseas Shooters must provide the following with the relevant forms in order to obtain a PNG Visitor's Firearm permit, PNG Customs and PNG Airline clearance.

1. Copy of your Passport photo page
2. Copy of Overseas Firearm license
3. 2 recent passport photographs with your printed name and signature on the back.
4. Complete residential address overseas
5. Copy of Driver's license number
6. Flight Details
7. Supply a letter from the Competition Organizers and/or your PGA confirming your participation and the events you are participating in.

Visitors Firearms Licences.

All shooters will be required to be issued with a PNG Visiting Shooter Licence for every firearm they wish to bring into PNG. This license must be applied for 50 days prior to the arrival of the competitor. There will be a fee of A\$100 per Firearm payable.

Ammunition.

Shooters may bring their competition ammunition to PNG but this should be checked with the carrier operating from their country. Ammunition may be subject to a weight check to confirm the legal loads are not exceeded. The quantity and details of ammunition being imported must be included in the Customs Application Form and must be submitted at the same time as the Visitor's firearm license.

PNG Import / Export Requirements

All necessary forms will be supplied to all competing countries.

All Shooters have to complete these forms listing details of all firearms, spare parts and types, calibre and amounts of ammunition that is being brought into PNG and submit with the application for a PNG Visiting Shooter License.

When you arrive in PNG you must declare all firearms to PNG Customs officials who will;

- check your passport
- check your firearms licence issued by the country you live in
- check your PNG visitors firearms licence and import permit
- check the firearms and ammunition listed on the permits issued.

Before you leave PNG, you must visit the Customs Office at the airport before check in. You will need to present your Passport, Firearms License, Customs Import/Export Permit along with your firearms for inspection and clearance.

Armories

Police approved storage and secure armories will be provided for the duration of the games. Additional information will be advised to all competing countries of the location of the armories.

No firearm or ammunition will be allowed to be stored at the Games Village or any other venue outside of the approved Armories.

Competition Rules

The competition will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the International Shooting Sport Federation and Oceania Shooting Federation.
