NZ POLICE Firearm Importation:

NOTE: NZ Firearm Permits must be applied for at least THREE MONTHS prior to arrival in NZ – If you do not have a permit, you will not get your firearm into NZ

NZ Police no longer have staff in the International Terminal office therefore after picking up your luggage you will need to find the police desk located inside the baggage area.
