Event.

300 Targets shot over three days

All events off 15 metres

- Day one 100 Target DTL
- Day two 100 Target Single Barrel
- Day Three 100 Target Points Score

Competition.

Time 9:30am to 5pm

There will be a 30 min lunch break each day

Practice/Training. Available 8th May 2025 from 9:30am to 5:00 pm

Teams Events will consist of.

- Three Person Open Teams.
- All teams can be of mixed gender.
- Australia and New Zealand will be allocated *One Open Team plus up to three individual entries*
- All other countries, *One Open Team plus up to eight individual entries*
- All countries are encouraged to include junior entries where possible
- Junior age – “Under 21 on the 1st day of competition” (as per ISSF rules)

Medals.

Open Individual 1st, 2nd, and 3rd over each day
Juniors' Individual 1st, 2nd, and 3rd over each day - See notes ABC below
Open Teams 1st, 2nd, and 3rd over each day
Three Day High Gun - HOA, 1st Individual, 1st Junior

- HOA medals/trophies to be supplied by the host country
 - First to third medals to be supplied by OSF
- A. Junior individual medals will only be allocated if two or more countries enter juniors
B. If there are not sufficient juniors entered to make a junior competition: The juniors that do attend will compete in the Open individual grade and/or open teams.
C. If a junior competes and wins a medal in the Open Individual grade, they will not be eligible for a junior medal on that day of competition.

Shoot Offs – Individual placings - As per “agreed country” rules

Teams.

These will be concluded after the final round on each day.

Tied teams will shoot 5 targets per shooter of the day's respective event, the scores will be re-calculated. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

All other rules as per Host or Nominated Country Rules

(This decision to be made before the commencement of the event and advised no later than the close of the technical meeting)

Technical Meeting.

To be held at 1pm at the Range the day prior to start of Competition - Thursday 8th May 2025
Rules and program can be revised prior to each Oceania, but no later than the date above.
